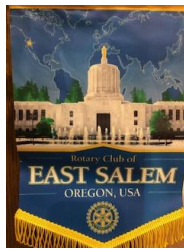

EAST SALEM ROTARY - AVENUES OF SERVICE

The mission of Rotary International is to provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill and peace through its fellowship of business, professional and community leaders.

Based on the Object of Rotary, the Avenues of Service are Rotary's philosophical cornerstone and the foundation on which club activity is based. East Salem Rotary provides a wide variety of service activities.

Please check all those committees in which you may be interested. Members of these committees will contact you to provide more information and answer your questions.

- Club Service** – This committee focuses on strengthening fellowship and ensuring the effective functioning of the club. This committee plans and initiates a variety of activities promoting fellowship and friendship.
 - **Membership committee:** Recruits, enrolls and acclimates new members
 - **Social committee:** Plans social/fellowship activities and follows up with absent members
 - **Communications committee:** Promotes internal and external club communication
 - **Program committee:** Secures speakers for weekly meetings
 - **Fundraising committee:** Organizes and implements our annual fundraising events. Funds raised support club activities and projects throughout the year. All members support this project, but club members with knowledge of non-profit fundraising are encouraged to join this committee.

- Vocational Service** – This committee encourages club members to serve others through their vocations and to practice high ethical standards in their business. This committee helps to organize offsite meetings, tours of local businesses, and mentorship opportunities with the local schools.

- Community Service** – This committee organizes the local projects and activities our club undertakes to improve life in our local community.

- World Community Service** – This committee coordinates our club's activities to improve life in our global community. The primary focus of this committee is identifying and coordinating worthy international projects for our club to undertake or become a partner with other Rotary clubs as we work to build peace through our service.

- New Generations** – This committee focuses on the youngest generation in the family of Rotary. Many are participants in Rotary's youth and young adult programs (Interact, Rotaract, RYLA). This committee also works to coordinate student of the month recognitions with our local schools.
 - **Youth Exchange committee:** Recruits, selects and supports foreign exchange students and host families for visiting students.
